

Privacy Policy

We are committed to the protection of your privacy. Our aim is to provide an online environment which will ensure the information you provide to us will be handled in a secure, efficient and confidential manner. What information do we collect and store?

Security, quality and accuracy of information

We will endeavour to correct your personal information within three (3) business days of receiving a written request from you.

While we will take all due care in protecting the security, confidentiality and privacy of the information submitted by you, we cannot guarantee that our systems will be completely free from third party interception or damage to information transmitted by email which is caused by viruses.
